Three Days That Defined the Future of Kazakhstan's Agribusiness

From October 22 to 24, 2025, the largest agricultural exhibitions in Central Asia — KazAgro/KazFarm-2025 — took place at the "EXPO" International Exhibition Center in Astana, organized by the International Exhibition Company ExpoGroup under the leadership of Sholpan Kozhabaeva.

The event reaffirmed its status as the region's main agribusiness platform, bringing together 316 companies from 25 countries and attracting more than 10,000 visitors across an exhibition area of 20,000 square meters.



International Scale and Global Participation

The exhibitions once again became a space where technology, science, and business converge.

Companies from Germany, the Czech Republic, Austria, Belarus, China, Russia, Iran, the United States, Turkey, Spain, and other countries took part in the event.

National and collective pavilions showcased cutting-edge solutions for crop production, animal husbandry, and agricultural product processing.

The active participation of foreign delegations, diplomatic missions, and international organizations further strengthened KazAgro/KazFarm's status as a key communication platform in Central Asia.



Business Program

The program featured more than 20 events, including conferences, panel discussions, seminars, workshops, and B2B and B2G meetings.

Key topics focused on digitalization and the implementation of artificial intelligence in agriculture, modern approaches to agricultural education, sustainable feed production, and the integration of science and business.



Key Highlights and Outcomes

One of the key events was the **AgroHub: Science and Business** contracting conference, which brought together **33 subsidiary organizations of the National Agrarian Science and Educational Center**.

- 10 agreements were signed for a total amount exceeding 700 million tenge, including:
- the establishment of a Russian-Kazakh AgroBioTech Park;
- the signing of licensing agreements for innovative developments.

For the first time, the Belarus-Kazakhstan Agrarian Forum was also held, organized with the support of the Embassy of Belarus. As a result, contracts worth more than 90 million USD were concluded.



Innovation and Digital Technologies

About 30 companies presented solutions in the fields of

- · precision agriculture,
- GNSS navigation,
- · drones and remote sensing,
- as well as agricultural software and online platforms.

These technologies are shaping a new face of Kazakhstan's agribusiness, making it efficient, sustainable, and competitive.



Next Generation and Startups

Special attention was given to youth engagement.

The "Auyl" Party organized an AgroHackathon — a platform for student startups and agri-tech ideas, evaluated by practicing farmers.

The best projects will receive support for further implementation.



Results and Recognition

Over the course of three days, the exhibitions were attended by 10,350 visitors — including farmers, investors, representatives of government bodies, research centers, and foreign delegations.

KazAgro/KazFarm-2025 received high praise from participants, who noted the excellent organization, practical value, and productive business atmosphere.

The event became a focal point for everyone shaping the future of Kazakhstan's agricultural sector.



Looking Ahead

ExpoGroup plans to further develop international cooperation and strengthen its focus on digital farming and artificial intelligence.



The next KazAgroFarm-2026 exhibitions will be held in Astana from October 21 to 23, 2026.
